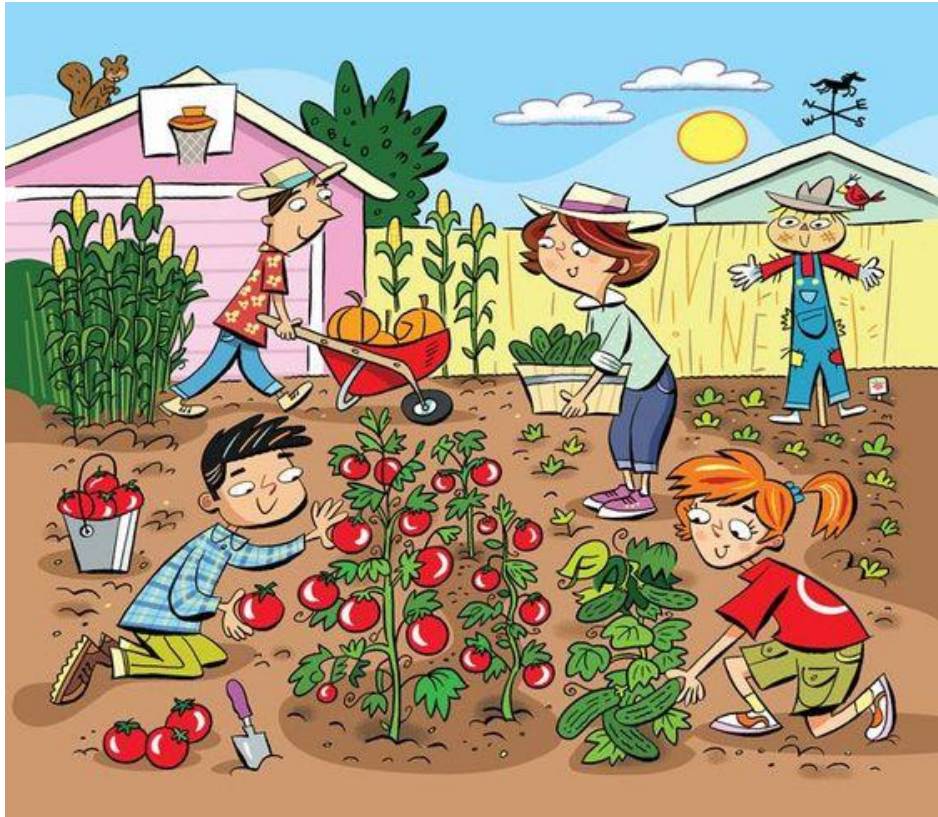


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Activity 1

In the Vegetable Garden

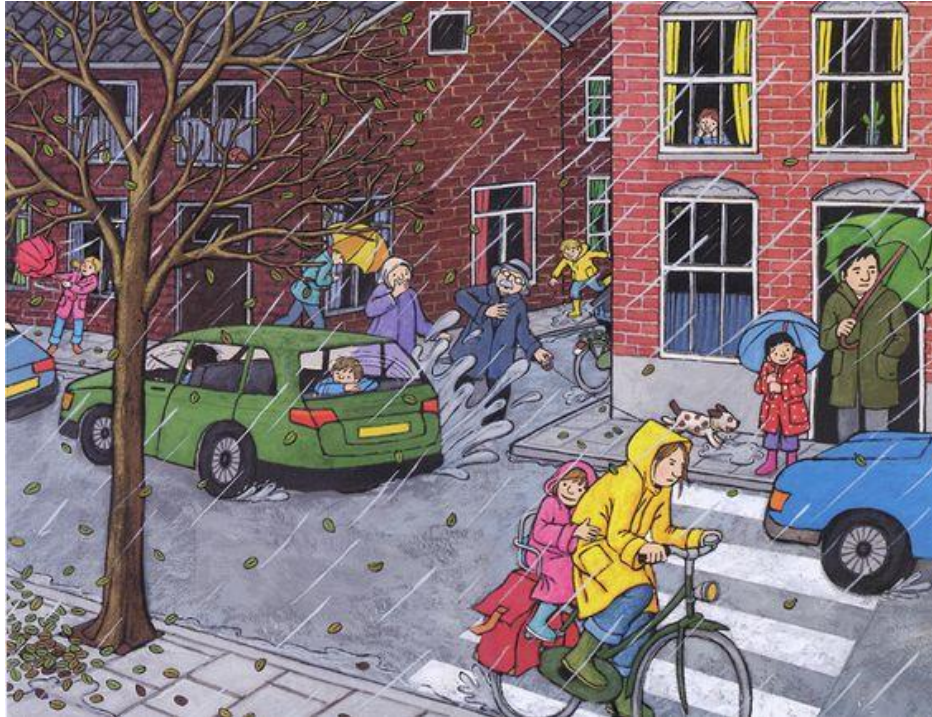


- Where are the people?

In a rainy day

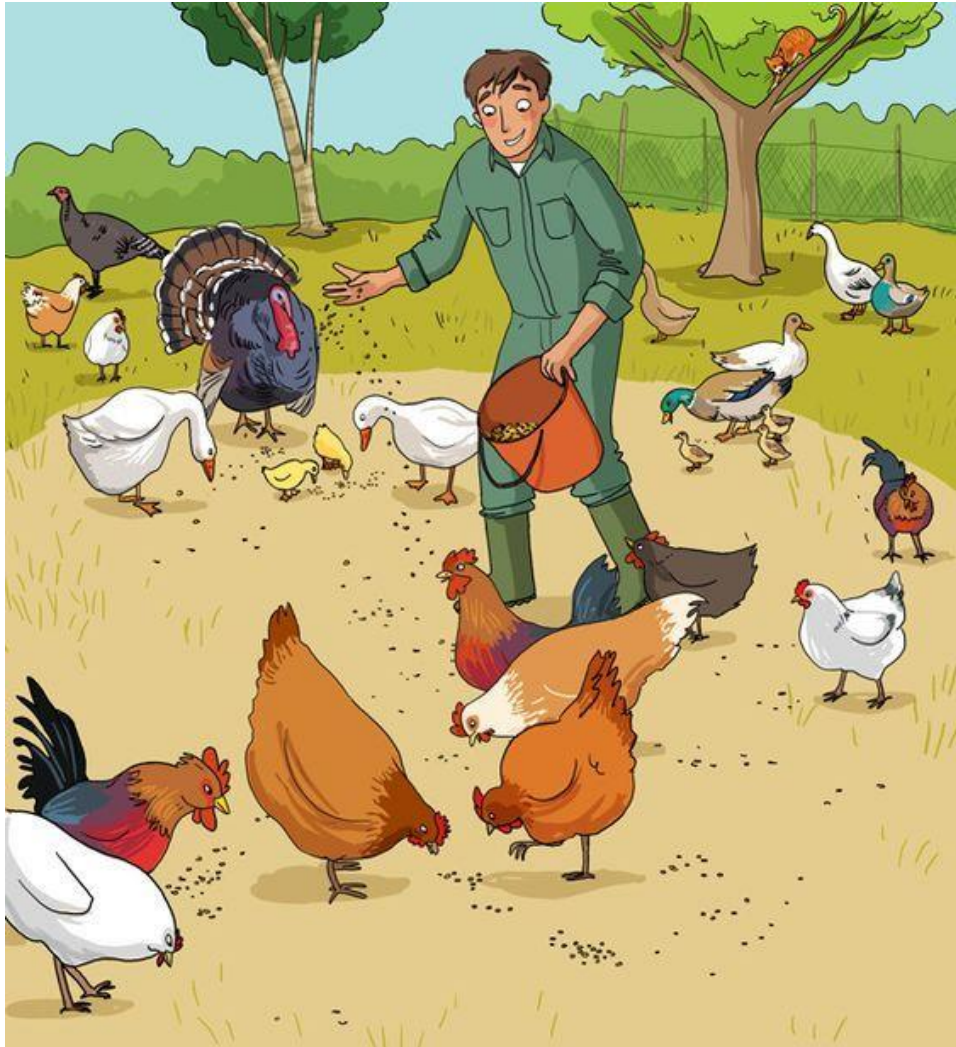


- What is the weather like in the picture?

On the Farm

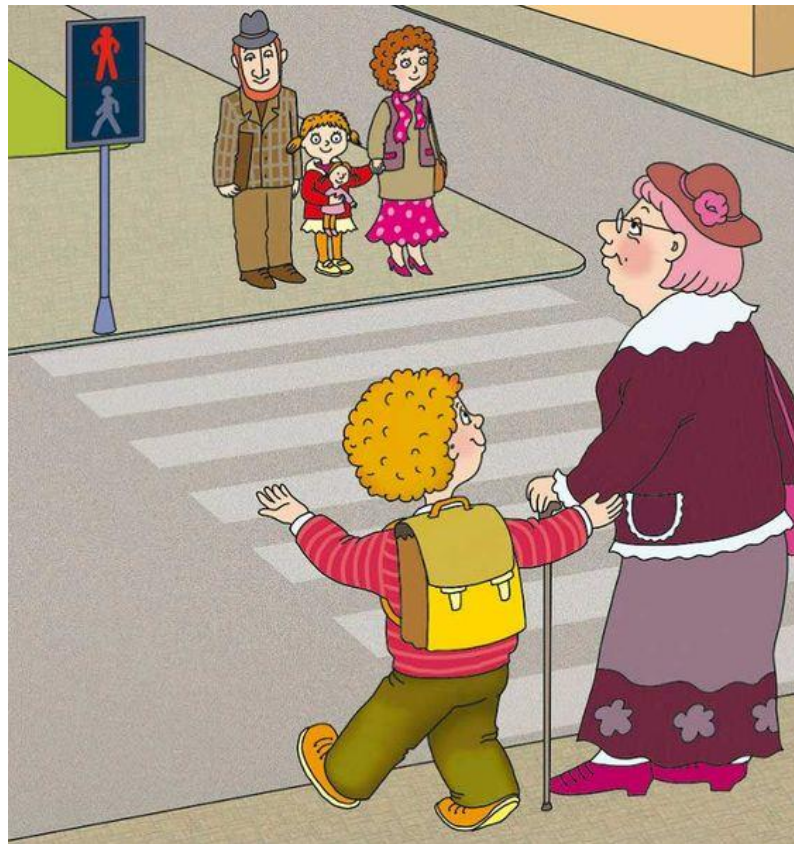


- Where is this man?

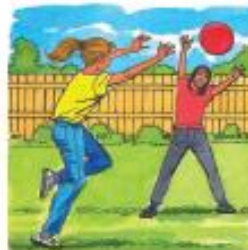

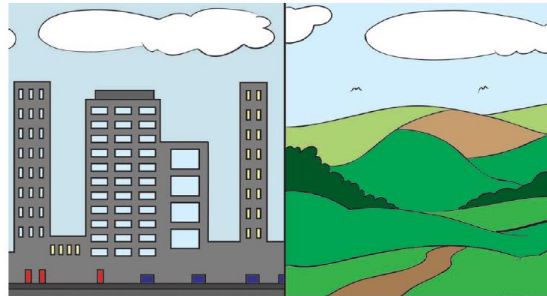
